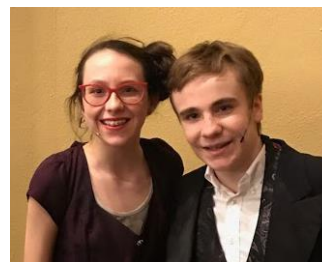
SETON'S GOT TALENT
